### Details:

- One week of foreign travel with a small team of educators (4-6 people), creating an effective training team
- Raising support from family and friends, church members and fellow teachers (cost – approximately \$1500)
- Travel insurance included
- Interacting with adult colleagues in an international setting... foreign language skill not required (translators will be available)
- Teaching educators in an assigned professional development area such as curriculum, classroom management, differentiation, and integrating the Christian faith into daily plans
- Mission planning meetings (in person or via skype) leading up to the trip
- Great lessons in trust, commitment, humility, and flexibility
