We often thank the Lord for the many daily gifts He bestows: food and clothing, good health, protection... and especially - grace, forgiveness, assurance of salvation, and peace.

It is personally good and beneficial to give thanks; yet, it is also of great benefit to others if we share what God has done for us.

- When Joseph met with his brothers, he said, "Do not be distressed because you sold me here, for God sent me before you to preserve life."
- When the shepherds saw the newborn baby lying in the manger, they rushed out to tell others about what they had seen and heard.
- When the disciples were told by the elders and chief priest to stop publicly talking about Jesus, they said, "we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard."

Our own stories of God's provision are different from those listed in God's Word...and from each other's stories. But they should not only be internalized; they should also be proclaimed. Our stories are a proclamation of the goodness of our loving and caring God.

The children who attend a school or an educational enrichment program at one of our LeadaChild project sites also need to hear the stories of God's goodness and grace...found in God's Word and experienced in the lives of those who lead and teach them. The primary emphasis during our educational workshops for teachers and leaders is to help them develop Gospel-rich environments within their classrooms – places to hear about the Good News of the Gospel...and to share the good things that God is accomplishing daily, right in their midst.

When children learn that God is present and working among them, the Bible and the truth about Jesus become more than abstract ideas. They come to realize that God loves them as His dear children...and they simply can't be quiet about it. When children know that Jesus loves them, they become the best proclaimers!


As we begin the second half of the decade, our commitment remains the same:
